
PREFACE

Is for "Hello!" You answer the call. "More margin," says broker; "Your stocks had a fall."






I Stands for Interest, which runs night and day And gradually eats all profits away.

K Stands for Keene, a man of great fame, Who is "keen" in his business, as well as in name.







Stands for Losses, and L stands for Lend. If you lend to pay losses, You'll lose money and friend.

Stands for "Nipper"; That's Northern Pacific. It goes up sometimes at a pace that's terrific.






Stands for Ocean; there's water in there— And a lot down in Wall Street, so do have a care.




P Stands for Profits and, no matter how small, Take it, or there'll be no profit at all.

T Is for Tips; avoid them like poison, Or else you'll be troubled with feet that are frozen.




Is for Visions of wealth that you dream, But remember things seldom are what they seem.

I got there myself; now you'll do the same.


